The policy of the Building Department and Environmental Health regarding hood and ventilation requirements for cooking equipment shall be as follows:

- 1. Microwave ovens may be installed without any type of hood or ventilation.
- 2. Commercial cooking devices other than those listed above and all gas or electric cooktop surfaces shall be provided with *code complying ventilating commercial hoods* as defined in the IMC.
- 3. Residential ranges in "B" office and "R" occupancies other than individual dwelling units that do not prepare food commercially can be installed with a residential hood provided it contains a listed UL300A fire suppression system. The fire suppression system should be connected to the fire alarm system in buildings that have a fire alarm.
